**Special Notes** : 1. The items shall be brand new, unused & of prime quality. Bidder shall warrant (in the event of an order) that the product supplied will be free from all defects & fault in material, workmanship & manufacture and shall be in full conformity with ordered specifications. This clause shall be valid for 18 months from date of despatch/shipment or 12 months from date of successful commissioning of the items at site which ever is earlier. The defective materials, if any, rejected by us shall be replaced by the supplier at their own expense. Bidders must confirm the same while quoting.

2. The minimum FOB/FCA charges in case of partial order for reduced quantity/ items shall have to be indicated by the bidder. In case this is not indicated specifically, the charges quoted would be prorata calculated and the same will be binding on the bidder.

3. Bidders to note that Govt. of India under Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED) Act 2006, has proclaimed the Public Procurement Policy, 2012 with effect from 1st April, 2012 in respect of procurement of goods and services, produced and provided by micro and small enterprises, by its Ministries, Departments and Public Sector Undertakings for promotion and development of Micro and Small Enterprises. A new Clause on applicability of Public Procurement Policy for procurement of goods from Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE) in the tender is furnished vide Amendment to General Terms and Conditions for Global Tender (MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005). Bidders are requested to take note of the same and to submit their offers accordingly wherever applicable.
4. Bidder shall be OEM or authorised dealer of OEM. Valid dealership certificate with warranty back up from OEM should be enclosed along with the bid or else the offer will be rejected.
5. Bidders to take note of clause no.10.1.3 which has been added in Section-C, special terms & conditions for Indian bidders of General Terms and Conditions for Global Tender (MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005-July2012) regarding transportation of materials.
6. The General Terms & Conditions for Global Tenders (MM/GLOBAL/01/2005) has been amended and the amendment dated 25.04.2016 have been issued in this regard which is uploaded in OIL Website. Bidders to note the changes made to "The General Terms & Conditions for Global Tenders (MM/GLOBAL/012005)" and to submit their offers complying with the same.
7. Validity of the offers should be 90 days from the date of bid opening. Bids with lesser validity shall be rejected.
8. Quotation must be submitted in triplicate.
9. The items covered by this enquiry shall be used by Oil India Limited in the PEL/ML areas which are issued/renewed after 01/04/99 and hence Nil Customs Duty during import will be applicable for foreign bidders. Indigenous bidder shall be eligible for concessional rate of IGST against Essentiality Certificate wherever applicable as per Notification No.3/2017-Integrated Tax (Rate) dated 28th June, 2017.
10. In view of implementation of GST w.e.f. 01.07.2017, The General Terms & Conditions for Global Tender(MM/GLOBAL/01/2005) has been amended and the Addendum dated 21.08.2017 has been issued in this regard which is uploaded in OIL Website. Bidders to note the changes made to "The General Terms & Conditions for Global Tenders (MM/GLOBAL/01/2005)" and to submit their offers complying with the same.
11. Bidders to note that Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas, Government of India implemented PPLC Policy to provide Purchase Preference (linked with local content) by notification no. Ref. O-27011/44/2016-ONG-II/FP dtd.25.04.2017. A new Clause on applicability of Purchase Preference (linked with local content) policy in the tender is furnished vide addedndum dated 21.08.2017 to General Terms and Conditions for Global Tender (MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005). Bidders are requested to take note of the same and to submit their offers accordingly wherever applicable.
12. The bidder shall furnish a list of spares that will be required for regular operation and maintenance etc.throughout the life of the equipment complete with the price if each item along with the bid. The price quoted for recommended spares will not be taken in to account for bid evaluation.
13. The bidder shall require to produce the test certificate (in original from OEM) of the equipment at it's time of delivery.

14. The bidder shall furnish detailed technical drawings and literature along with the bid for technical evaluation.

15. Installation & Commissioning:

Installation & Commissioning of the equipment carried out by supplier's competent engineer(s) at Duliajan, Assam (India). During Installation & Commissioning, the supplier shall demonstrate / train OIL personnel about the operation and maintenance of the equipment Installation / Commissioning charges, if any must be quoted separately on lumpsum basis which shall be considered for evaluation of the offer.

While quoting Installation/Commissioning charges, bidder should take into account all charges including to and fro fares, boarding/lodging, and other daily expenses of the commissioning personnel. OIL may provide accommodation on chargeable basis subject to availability. Income, Service, Corporate Taxes etc, if any, towards Installation/ Commissioning and training will be to supplier's account and will be deducted at source.

Offers without indicating the Installation / Commissioning charges shall be loaded with the maximum Installation / Commissioning charges received against this tender for evaluation purpose.

Moreover, if Income / Service taxes are not categorically mentioned in their offer, then such offers shall be loaded with the applicable rate of taxes for evaluation purpose.

16. The bidders should also submit a list of companies in India to whom they sold this particular equipment which are presently in operation. The supplier may also be required to provide after sales service in India.

17. All documents should be provided in English language. At the time of supply (Hard Copy/ Softcopy)of Operational & maintenance Manual,Chart Reader Program Manual and Parts Catalogue should be provided.

18. Bidder should provide list of recommended spares parts list for two years operation to be used after expiry of warranty period.

19. Payment : Payment shall be released as follows :

i) 80 % of the of the order value shall be paid against proof of despatch/shipment of the goods.

ii) Remaining 20 % of the order value along with commissioning charges, shall be paid after successful commissioning and acceptance of the unit by OIL.

iii) OIL may also consider making 100 % payment towards supply of the units against proof of despatch provided bidders agree to pay interest for 20 % of the order value and also submit Bank Guarantee for the amount equivalent to 20 % of the order value.

iv) Payment towards Installation/Commissioning shall be released on successful completion of the Installation/Commissioning programme.

Any offer not complying with the above shall be loaded at one percent above the prevailing Bank Rate (CC rate) of State Bank of India for evaluation purpose.

20. Successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance Security equivalent to ten (10%) of total evaluated value of Order, which should remain valid throughout the period execution, including extension, if any. The successful bidder shall submit Performance Security within 30 days of award, failing which OIL reserves the right to cancel the order and forfeit their Bid Security. Bidders should undertake in their bids to submit Performance Security as stated above.
