In the event of late registration/incomplete registration by Bidder, OIL INDIA LIMITED shall not be responsible for late allotment of User ID & Password and request for bid closing date extension on that plea shall not be entertained by Company.
- 5.0 Bidders to note that Govt. of India under Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED) Act 2006, has proclaimed the Public Procurement Policy, 2012 with effect from 1st April, 2012 in respect of procurement of goods and services, produced and provided by micro and small enterprises, by its Ministries, Departments and Public Sector Undertakings for promotion and development of Micro and Small Enterprises. A new Clause on applicability of Public Procurement Policy for procurement of goods from Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE) in the tender is furnished vide Amendment to General Terms and Conditions for Global Tender (MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005). - 14.0 Any deviation(s) from the tender specification should be clearly highlighted specifying justification in support of deviation.

- 15.0 Original Bid Closing Date shall be considered by OIL for evaluation of BRC Criteria in case of any extension of the original bid closing date.

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- 18.0 For the convenience of the qualified Bidders and to improve transparency, the rates/costs quoted by bidders against OIL’s e-tenders shall be available for online viewing by such Bidders whose price bids are opened by Company. A Bidder can view item-wise rates/costs of all other such peer bidders against the tender immediately after price bid opening, if the e-tender is floated by Company with PRICE CONDITION. In case the Price Bid is invited by Company through attachment form under “Notes & Attachments” (i.e., NO PRICE CONDITION), Bidder must upload their detailed Price-Bid as per the prescribed format under “Notes & Attachment”, in addition to filling up the “Total Bid Value” Tab taking into account the cost of all individual line items and other applicable charges like freight, tax, duties, levies etc.. Under NO PRICE Condition (i.e. Price Bid in attachment form), the “Total Bid Value” as calculated & quoted by the Bidder shall only be shared amongst the eligible bidders and Company will not assume any responsibility whatsoever towards calculation errors/omissions therein, if any.

Notwithstanding to sharing the “Total Bid Value” or the same is whether filled up by the Bidder or not, Company will evaluate the cost details to ascertain the inter-se-ranking of bidders strictly as per the unloaded attachment and Bid Evaluation Criteria only. 1.0 The corrosion inhibitor shall be film forming type oil soluble and qualified as per MIL-QPL-25017-19 (15 March 2001)

2.0 **Packing:** Materials are to be supplied in brand new non-returnable MS Cask.

Note

- (i) Corrosion inhibitor shall be in latest "Qualified products list Category-1 of Products qualified under performance specification MIL-PRF-25017G or the latest as applicable for Inhibitor. The Documentary proof in support of compliance to aforementioned specifications shall be submitted along with the technical bid.
 - (ii) Corrosion inhibitor has to be shear stable and effective during flow through Cross country petroleum pipelines. During field monitoring, corrosion rate throughout the pipeline shall be less than 1 mpy. The vendor shall provide in house laboratory test data and performance certification from end user and test result from a reputed laboratory with details of dosage rate in ppm, achieved corrosion rate in mils per year (mpy) duly certified by manufacturer as per NACE standard RP-0775-99 latest edition.
 - (iii) Corrosion inhibitor shall be fuel soluble and designed to protect the quality of finished products (MS, SKO, HSD & Naphtha) and also act as lubricity improver for pipelines.
 - (iv) Bidder to submit clientele list of their product along with the bid.
 - (v) **The Corrosion Inhibitor should have at least 18 months of shelf life at the time of receipt at OIL's site.** Bidder should ensure that the shelf-life of the Corrosion Inhibitor is 18 months at the time of receipt by OIL. Bidder should confirm the same in their bid. Bidder should note that the transportation time for Indian bidders till receipt of goods at OIL's site is approximately 3 (three) months.
- 3.0 **Third Party Inspection:** Corrosion Inhibitor to be supplied must be tested, inspected and certified by OIL's approved TPIA (M/s. Lloyds, M/s. Rites, M/s. I.R.S., M/s DNV, M/s. BV and M/s. Tuboscope Vetco). Scope of TPIA as under:
- (i) TPI agency shall ensure that all tests required for Manufacturing and Quality / Performance of the product to be carried out at their approved laboratories only. Test reports shall be certified by the TPI agency.
 - (ii) TPI agency shall witness the laboratory tests required as per NACE-RP-0775-99 latest edition.
 - (iii) Certify that the material is manufactured and tested as per NACE standard & OIL's specification.

BID REJECTION CRITERIA & BID EVALUATION CRITERIA**I. BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):**

The bids must conform to the specifications, terms and conditions given in the tender document. Bids shall be rejected in case the items offered do not conform to the required minimum/ maximum parameters stipulated in the technical specifications and to the respective international /national standards wherever stipulated.

Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bids to the stipulated specifications and terms and conditions, the offer/ offers will be considered as non-responsive and is/are liable to be rejected, if the following conditions are not fulfilled:

(A) TECHNICAL

- 1.0 Bidder shall be either a manufacturer or a supplier, authorized by manufacturer for the quoted material. The quoted materials shall conform to specifications and applicable/ relevant Codes or standards.
- 2.0 The bidder - manufacturer or a supplier authorized by a manufacturer, should have experience of supplying Corrosion Inhibitor, as per the technical specification specified in the tender for Liquid Hydrocarbon Pipelines, for a minimum quantity of 9,215 KG in a single order during last 5(five) years reckoned from the original bid closing date.

Note: For the purpose of above clause, the date of those purchase order(s)/Contract(s) need not be within five (5) years preceding the bid closing date of the tender, but the date of execution must fall within the period of five (5) years prior to the original bid closing date of the tender.

- 3.0 In case the bidder is a manufacturer:

- 3.1 The manufacturer shall be a regular manufacturer of the materials of same brand as quoted for.
- 3.2 The manufacturer shall have manufactured and supplied the materials of offered type since last 5(years) years reckoned from original bid closing date.

- 4.0 In case the bidder is a supplier, authorized by the manufacturer, the following criteria shall be met by the bidder:

- 4.1 The bidder shall supply the materials produced by an established manufacturer, who meets the technical specification specified in the tender. The bidder shall meet the qualification requirement stipulated herein under 2.0 above for supply of the quoted materials of the same manufacturer.
- 4.2 The bidder shall furnish an authority certificate from the manufacturer, confirming the bidder's status as their authorized supplier. The authority certificate shall be valid up to the completion tenure of order as per the bid document.
- 5.0 A job/supply executed by a bidder for its own organization/subsidiary cannot be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting Bid Rejection Criteria/ Bid Evaluation Criteria.
- 6.0 One manufacturer can quote only through one supplier.
- 7.0 One supplier can quote based on an authority letter from one manufacturer only.
- 8.0 The bid shall be rejected, in case of any change of the manufacturer for the aforesaid materials after submission of bid.

9.0 The bidder shall furnish documentary evidence such as purchase order, inspection release note or completion certificate of relevant previous supplies or Tax Invoice or Payment Certificate or Consignee receipted delivery challan or Performance Certificate from owner of the pipeline where the Corrosion Inhibitor offered in their bid has been supplied, in support of meeting the above qualification criteria along with the bid otherwise, the bid will be considered as non - responsive and shall be liable for rejection.

10.0 In absence of requisite documents in support of the above clauses, OIL reserves the right to reject the bid without making any reference to bidders.

11.0 DELIVERY PERIOD: Materials must be delivered as per the below schedule –

(i) **Quantity: 7,030 KG**

At PHQ, Guwahati within 5 months from the date of issue of PO.

(ii) **Quantity: 11,400 KG**

At Numaligarh Terminal: 1st lot of 5,700 KG within 3 months from the date of issue of PO. Balance 5,700 KG after 3 months from the delivery of the first lot at site.

(B) FINANCIAL:

1.0 Annual Financial Turnover of the bidder during any of preceding three financial/accounting years from the original bid closing date should be at least **INR 15,35,126.85**.

2.0 **Net Worth** of the bidder should be positive for the financial/accounting year just preceding to the original Bid Closing Date of the Tender (i.e. FY 2018 - 19).

3.0 Considering the time required for preparation of Financial Statements, if the last date of preceding financial/accounting year falls within the preceding six months reckoned from the original bid closing date and the Financial Statements of the preceding financial/accounting year are not available with the bidder, then the financial turnover of the previous three financial/accounting years excluding the preceding financial /accounting year will be considered. - 3.0 Bidders must confirm that goods or materials to be supplied shall be brand new of recent make and of the best quality and shall be guaranteed for a period of 18 months from the date of receipt of materials at site against any defects arising from faulty materials. Defective goods/materials by OIL shall be replaced immediately by the supplier at the supplier's expenses at no extra cost to OIL.
- 4.0 MSME Bidders are exempted from payment of Bid Security (EMD) irrespective of their product category & capacity, subject to submission of valid MSME registration certificate issued by appropriate authority. Bids without EMD shall be rejected, if the technical offer does not include a valid copy of relevant MSE Certificate issued by appropriate authority.
- 5.0 The prices offered will have to be firm through delivery and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- 6.0 **Validity of the bid shall be minimum 90 days from the final Bid Closing date. Bids with lesser validity will be rejected.**
